VILLAGE OF MEATH PARK BYLAW NO. 01-2021

A BYLAW OF THE VILLAGE OF MEATH PARK TO ISSUE WATER CONSERVATION MEASURES

The Council of the Village of Meath Park in the Province of Saskatchewan enacts as follows:

- 1. On the advice of the Water Treatment Plant Operator or her/his designate the:
 - a) Administrator
 - b) Administrators Designate
 - c) Water Treatment Plant Operator or,
 - d) Water Treatment Plant Operators Designate

may issue water conservation measures for any consumers of water provided by the Village of Meath Park Water Treatment Plant.

- 2. The water conservation measures may include but are not limited to restrictions for the use of water for grass, gardens, swimming pools, or any outdoor use of water.
- 3. The issuance of water conservation measures will be made by posting a notice in the Village Office, and bulletin board by the Post Office stating the details of the water restrictions and the effective date.
- 4. Anyone found to be in contravention of a water conservation measure restriction issued pursuant to this bylaw may have their water connection terminated without notice and be fined not more than \$2500.00.
